We are targeting Middle School families to start providing this information early on, but this meeting is open to all families!

Topics will include: an overview of the transition section of the IEP, transition to adulthood, backwards planning, and the parental role in transition planning. An overview of agencies and community resources that support the transition planning process as well as other considerations as your child becomes an adult, such as voter registration, benefits, guardianship, etc. will be discussed as well.
