People Together participants should:

- Be comfortable with public speaking
- Have an interest in teaching others
- Be able to answer questions that students may ask in a timely manner
- Have independent transportation to and from events

Advocates who present at events, are paid an hourly minimum wage to cover the time they dedicate at each event.
